The Goals for Girls programme incorporates SKILLZ which is an interactive sport-based health education programme aimed at promoting sexual and reproductive health among adolescent girls. The SKILLZ coach will be directly responsible for conducting after school sport-based sexual and reproductive health sessions with 14-17 year old female secondary school learners.

This position will be based at Phillipi village in Cape Town with regular visits to the designated schools in the Klipfontein/Mitchels Plain study area and will receive a monthly stipend of R2,600 and R350 travel allowance.

Requirements:

- Grade 12
- Within the age 18 – 30 years old
- Female candidates preferred
- Must play- or have an understanding of the game of soccer and the associated rules
- Must have strong basic English language proficiency (Written and Verbal)
- Recent Police clearance certificate
- Must promote adolescent health and wellness and be passionate about working with children aged 14 – 17 years of age.
- Must have a non-judgmental attitude and take a public health view with regards to safe sex and contraception.
- Planning and organizing
- Interpersonal skills
