BREAKDOWN OF FEES FOR PG DIP IN TB-HIV MANAGEMENT (2018)

South African citizens	R43 582
International students – SADC region	R43 582 + R3750 admin fee Minimum payment of R27 250 required for registration.
International students – within Africa (outside of SADC region)	R43 582 + R41 040 international fee + R3750 admin fee Payment of full qualification fee required for registration (R88 372).
International students – outside Africa	R43 582 + R55 000 international fee + R3750 admin fee Minimum payment of R90 000 required for registration.

* **International fee:** this is payable for each year of registration.

International students may apply to the Faculty of Health Sciences (Postgraduate Office) for financial assistance to help them cover the international fee – see **Faculty International Student Bursary / FISB**.
